<b>Documents required for application</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Online application (a link will be sent to nominated students)</li> <li>• Digital photo (passport style)</li> <li>• Passport copy</li> <li>• Notarised translation of the passport into Russian</li> <li>• Transcript of records</li> <li>• Enrolment verification</li> </ul> <p><b>Please note</b> that the application is only valid when all above mentioned documents are uploaded to the online application form.</p>
<b>Visa application</b>	<p>Accepted exchange students will receive an official invitation prepared by the Federal Migration Service of the Russian Federation or the University of Tyumen (depending on the home country). The process of preparing the invitation may take <b>up to five weeks</b>.</p> <p>Students will then have to apply for a student visa via the Russian Consulate in their home country. The process may take <b>up to one month</b>.</p> <p>An initial visa will be issued <b>for 90 days</b>. Upon arrival in Tyumen, the International Office will extend the visa till the end of the study period. All the information concerning visa issues will be sent to incoming exchange students.</p>
<b>Tuition fee</b>	Waived for the University of Tyumen <u>partner institutions</u> .
